COMPLAINT

The Plaintiff, Commonwealth of Virginia, by, through, and at the relation of its Attorney General, Mark R. Herring (the "Plaintiff" or the "Commonwealth"), petitions this Court to declare that the activities in which the Defendant, Hobby Lobby Stores, Inc. ("Hobby Lobby" or the "Defendant"), has engaged constitute violations of § 59.1-207.42 of the Comparison Price Advertising Act ("CPAA"), Virginia Code §§ 59.1-207.40 through 59.1-207.44, and § 59.1-200(A)(30) of the Virginia Consumer Protection Act ("VCPA"), Virginia Code §§ 59.1-196 through 59.1-207. The Commonwealth prays that this Court grant the relief requested in this Complaint and states the following in support thereof:

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

1. The Commonwealth brings this CPAA and VCPA action pursuant to the authority set forth in § 59.1-203 of the VCPA, which provides, among other things, that the Attorney General may bring an action to enjoin any violation of the VCPA, which includes any violation of the CPAA, in accordance with §§ 59.1-207.44 and 59.1-200(A)(30).

- 2. The Circuit Court for Henrico County has authority to entertain this action and to grant the relief requested herein pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 8.01-620, 17.1-513, 59.1-203, 59.1-205, and 59.1-206.
- 3. Venue is preferred in this Court pursuant to Virginia Code § 8.01-261(15)(c) because some or all of the acts to be enjoined are, or were, being done in Henrico County. Venue is permissible in this Court pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 8.01-262(3) and (4) because the Defendant regularly conducts substantial business activity in Henrico County and portions of the cause of action arose in Henrico County.
- 4. In accordance with Virginia Code § 59.1-203(B), prior to commencement of this action, the Plaintiff gave the Defendant written notice that these proceedings were contemplated and a reasonable opportunity to appear before the Office of the Attorney General (the "Office") to demonstrate that no violations of the VCPA or CPAA had occurred, or, in the alternative, to execute an appropriate Assurance of Voluntary Compliance ("AVC") that is acceptable to the Commonwealth. The Defendant agreed to execute an AVC that is acceptable to the Commonwealth.

PARTIES

- 5. The Plaintiff is the Commonwealth of Virginia, by, through, and at the relation of Mark R. Herring, Attorney General of Virginia.
- 6. The Defendant, Hobby Lobby, is an Oklahoma corporation having its principal office at 7707 SW 44th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73179. Hobby Lobby's Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in the Commonwealth was issued by the Virginia State Corporation Commission on October 1, 2004.

FACTS

- 7. Hobby Lobby operates more than 500 stores nationally, including six stores in the Commonwealth. The Hobby Lobby in Henrico County is located at 11280 West Broad Street, Glen Allen, Virginia, 23060.
- 8. Hobby Lobby offers consumer goods including, but not limited to, furniture, art supplies, fabric, frames, and seasonal decor in stores nationwide.
- 9. Hobby Lobby advertises its merchandise to consumers through a variety of means including direct mail, print media, internet social media, on-line websites, and in-store signs and pamphlets.
- 10. In the past, some of these advertisements have referred to discounts off a "MARKED PRICE." The advertisements have further defined "MARKED PRICE" as "DISCOUNTS PROVIDED EVERY DAY; MARKED PRICES REFLECT COMPARABLE PRICES OFFERED BY OTHER SELLERS FOR SIMILAR PRODUCTS." A copy of one of the advertisements is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 11. Section 59.1-207.42(2) does not permit a supplier to advertise a comparison price unless the trade area to which the advertisement refers is clearly defined and disclosed.

CAUSES OF ACTION

COUNT I - COMPARISON PRICE ADVERTISING ACT

- 12. The Commonwealth re-alleges and incorporates by reference the allegations of Paragraphs 1 through 11 above.
- 13. The Defendant is now, and was at all relevant times mentioned herein, a supplier advertising the "comparison price" of goods or services, as that term is defined in § 59.1-207.40 of the CPAA.

- 14. In advertising the comparison price of goods or services to consumers, the Defendant has engaged in the following acts and practices, which are prohibited by the CPAA: Failing to clearly define and disclose the trade area to which any comparison price used in its advertisement refers, in violation of § 59.1-207.42(2).
- 15. Pursuant to § 59.1-200(A)(30), the Defendant's violation of § 59.1-207.42(2) also constitutes a violation of the VCPA.

COUNT II - VIRGINIA CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT

- 16. The Plaintiff re-alleges and incorporates herein by reference all matters set forth in Paragraphs 1 through 15 above.
- 17. The Defendant is now, and was at all relevant times mentioned herein, a "supplier" of "goods" or "services," and engaged in "consumer transactions," as those terms are defined in § 59.1-198 of the VCPA, by advertising, offering, and selling merchandise, including, but not limited to, furniture, art supplies, fabric, frames, and seasonal décor, to consumers.
- 18. Pursuant to § 59.1-200(A)(30), the Defendant's violation of § 59.1-207.42(2) also constitutes a violation of the VCPA.
- 19. The VCPA authorizes the Attorney General to seek, among other relief, restitution (§ 59.1-205) for any amounts that might have been acquired from persons by means of a violation of § 59.1-200, civil penalties of not more than \$2,500 per violation (§ 59.1-206), investigative costs and reasonable expenses not to exceed \$1,000 per violation, and attorneys' fees (§ 59.1-206).
- 20. The Defendant willfully committed the violations of §§ 59.1-207.42(2) and 59.1-200(A)(30).
- 21. Individual consumers have suffered monetary damages as a result of the aforesaid violations by the Defendant.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff, Commonwealth of Virginia, prays that this Court enter the Order Approving and Adopting Assurance of Voluntary Compliance filed herewith.


